WCBCS ACADEMIC PROGRESS POLICY

CREDIT HOURS

In order for a student to maintain satisfactory academic progress, they must:

- 1) Pass a minimum of 75% of all classes with a "C" average; and
- 2) Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Academic Warning

If any student fails to satisfy either of these conditions, the first time they will be given an academic warning via email informing them they must meet the minimum standards. If their performance does not improve, the student will be placed on Academic Probation.

Academic Probation & Appeal

Being placed on Academic Probation required a student to maintain a 2.0 GPA moving forward or they may be administratively withdrawn from their program. In this case, the student will receive an email and phone call from the WCBCS offices. Students have five (5) days to appeal this decision in writing. After five (5) it may not be appealed.

Letters grades will be assigned the following numeric point values:

- A = 4.0
- B = 3.0
- C = 2.0
- D = 1.0
- F = 0.0
