



Community Catalyst Mini-Grants
for Climate Change
Service Learning Projects

Goal: To support student and teacher initiated service learning projects that address climate change and sustainability issues, increase environmental literacy, and empower students to take action as environmental stewards.

Grant Size: Most grants are \$50 to \$250. Larger grants will be considered.

No Deadline: Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until funds are expended for the 2017-2018 school year. Grants will be awarded within 2-3 weeks.

Eligibility: Proposals are invited from AOS #91 teachers or students with teacher mentors.

Reporting Requirements: Grantees will be required to submit a simple report or student presentation to share the impact of the project on them, the community, and the environment upon completion. Students are encouraged to debrief the project when completed and find a creative way to share its impact with A Climate to Thrive and the school or larger community.
