On the gentle slopes of the Chehalem Mountains in Oregon's bountiful Willamette Valley lies Rain Dance Vineyard. Established in 2010, Rain Dance is planted to 15 acres of Pinot Noir on Jory, Panther and Hazelair soils. Driven by quality and inspiration, Rain Dance embraces the natural phenomenon of the Pacific Northwest. Where the sun and notable rain fall nourish roots that run deep.

Distinguished Taste

The 2013 Estate Pinot Noir is the inaugural vintage for Rain Dance Vineyards Released on May 1st 2015, the 2013 Estate Pinot Noir exhibits predominant aromas of berry and vanilla which are layered with that of cola, spice box, and cream. Supple tannins add a complex, rounded mouthfeel lending to a longer finish.
