On the gentle slopes of the Chehalem Mountains in Oregon's bountiful Willamette Valley lies Rain Dance Vineyard. Established in 2009, Rain Dance is planted to 15 acres of Pinot Noir on Jory soil. Driven by quality and inspiration, Rain Dance embraces the natural phenomenon of the Pacific Northwest, where the sun and notable rainfall nourish roots that run deep.

The Rain Dance Reserve is produced exclusively to showcase the powerful profile of the Pommard clone of Pinot Noir. Coming from Block 4 in our Rain Dance Estate Vineyard, this Pinot Noir is graceful and enticing with a mixed bouquet of rose petal, dark ripe cherry and toasted oats. On the pallet the wine is ripe, rich and earthy. Flavors of sweet wild blackberries and rhubarb make it beautifully concentrated. It is delicious and inviting with a long lingering finish. Savor this limited production Pinot Noir now through 2030.
