Happy New Year. I wish to thank Mount Olivet UMC for making the season of Advent so special for Chuck and myself. The cards, gifts, and love offering is greatly appreciated. It is my desire that we look toward the season of Epiphany with continued anticipation of the Messiah's presence.

The year 2019 began with lingering and unresolved discussions regarding the future of the United Methodist Church. Questions will continue to be asked as to what our future will be regarding the issues of ordination of professing homosexuals and same sex unions. No decisions have been made, only predictions and presumed ideas as to how the church will proceed moving forward.

In response to leading us (the church) in a positive direction, Bishop Paul Leland offers the following:

- Reflect rather than react. Be prayerful for the church. Remain objective. Since this is a negotiated proposal everyone is not entirely satisfied with the outcome, yet the denomination needs to look for the best solution to address its current impasse.
- Read the full agreement and pay attention to the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ), which will answer many questions raised by the proposal.
- The United Methodist Church remains The United Methodist Church, although there were some who were calling for the full dissolution of the denomination. All churches desiring to remain United Methodists will not need to do anything different or to make any further decisions.

Bishop Leland continues with this statement:

This Protocol tries to offer a respectable path forward that treats others with grace and respect. The primary question for me is how do we Glorify God and love others in our decisions? How can we be open to those who interpret and understand scripture differently as we worship God and serve neighbors while traveling along different paths of faithfulness?

As we look to the future of the church, I encourage everyone to be considerate of one another's feelings. This is a time to ask for God's guidance as we enter into a season of discernment. More information will be forthcoming in the next few months. Until then, our mission is to pray for our leaders, our community, and our church as we go forth making disciples of Christ.



What a blessed and extraordinary month we had in December. At the end of November, we were facing an annual deficit of (\$5,687.54). Our prayer was that we would have a large enough offering in December to cover most, if not all of the deficit; and with relatively low expenses, this was



possible.

Praise God! Our prayers were answered and we had our largest monthly offering of the year of \$34,095.51, which included \$1,386.26 on-line offerings. Yes, this is not a misprint, our December Offering was \$34,095.51! With expenses of only \$12,462.31, we ended the month with a surplus of \$21,633.20! We closed the year with total offerings of \$224.030.49 and total expenses of \$208,084.83, for a surplus of \$15,945.66.

What a blessing to end the year with a surplus and not a deficit. God has truly blessed us this year. We thank God for His blessings, and we thank all of his children who have given so generously for the support of His church here at Mt. Olivet. May you all have a Happy and Blessed New Year! *Charles Craver, Treasurer*



Pretend That You're Having a Heart Attack

The story is told of a married couple who enjoyed their luxury fishing boat together, but it was the husband who was always behind the wheel operating the boat. He was concerned about what might happen in an emergency. So one day out on the lake he said to his wife, "Please take the wheel, dear. Pretend that I am having a heart attack. You must get the boat safely to shore." So she drove the boat to shore.

Later that evening, the wife walked into the living room where her husband was watching television. She sat down next to him, switched the TV channel, and said to him, "Please go into the kitchen, dear. Pretend I'm having a heart attack. You must set the table, cook the dinner, and wash the dishes."

It's not a very pleasant thing to pretend such a thing, but there are some legitimate concerns we should have. I wouldn't consider it at all out of place for an insurance salesman to ask the question, "If you were to have a heart attack today, would your wife and children be taken care of?"

An even more important question, though, needs to be raised as we consider our spiritual relationship with God. If I were to have a heart attack tonight and die, would I be prepared to stand before the great judgment seat of Christ? It's a legitimate question. When I was a teenager, I thought that I would live forever. As I grow older, I become more and more aware of the fact that each day is a blessing provided by God, and I am not promised even one more.

"Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit'; whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away." (James 4:13-14)

I know it requires a degree of seriousness that may make you a bit uncomfortable, but just for a moment, pretend that you are having a heart attack. Are you prepared for eternity?
