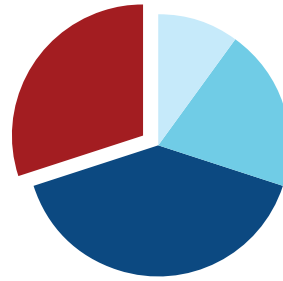


# CARDIOVASCULAR RX REJECTION:

## BY THE NUMBERS

**73 million**  
Americans have high LDL cholesterol<sup>1</sup>



**~28%**  
of Americans over age 40 take a statin<sup>1</sup>, but that may not be sufficient for everyone

Adding **PCSK9 inhibitors** can:



Reduce patients' cholesterol by up to **60%**<sup>2</sup>



Reduce heart attack risk by **27%**



Reduce stroke risk by **21%**



Reduce risk of death by **15%**<sup>3</sup>

**BUT...**

In 2017, commercial health plans **rejected almost half** of patients prescribed a PCSK9 inhibitor<sup>4</sup>



Individual health plans **rejected** as many as **97%** of heart patients



**>78,000** patients couldn't access their prescribed Rx
