

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Is the The Dan Marino Foundation a nonprofit organization?

A: Yes, The Dan Marino Foundation is a non-profit 501c3 organization as determined by the IRS.

Q: How much of my donation will go to support direct services and programs?

A: Eighty-seven cents of every dollar raised by The Dan Marino Foundation directly funds programs and services.

Q: How can I make a donation to The Dan Marino Foundation?

Q: Does The Dan Marino Foundation participate in corporate matching gift programs?

A: Yes! Please ask your employer about corporate matching gifts. Many companies sponsor matching gift programs that will match charitable contributions made by their employees. Some even match gifts made by retirees and/or spouses. These programs are a great way for companies to support The Dan Marino Foundation and a chance for you to double or even triple your gift! Here's how to make a matching gift:

Check with your human resources department to find out whether your company has a matching gift policy. If it does, your employer will usually provide a form for you to fill out and send to us with your donation. We will confirm your gift and return the form to your company, which will then issue a matching gift contribution directly to the Foundation.
