Dear Community Member:

Thank you for your interest in Killingly Energy Center's (KEC) Permit Application for Stationary Sources of Air Pollution – New Source Review. We wanted to let you know that consistent with CTDEEP regulations, KEC has recently completed an Ambient Air Quality Analysis for the facility. This document provides important information demonstrating KEC's compliance with all applicable ambient air quality standards.

Our air quality analysis was completed following Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) and United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) guidelines. The analysis is based on a number of highly conservative assumptions. Put another way, the analysis intentionally overstates the project's impacts to ensure protection of air quality. Even with these conservative assumptions, KEC's modeled impacts are well within all applicable ambient air quality standards that have been established to protect even the most sensitive individuals.

KEC will be among the cleanest, most efficient natural gas power generation facilities in North America. KEC will utilize state-of-the-art electric generation technology, allowing it to operate 25% more efficiently than the average electric generator in Connecticut. This means KEC will displace the operation of older, higher-emitting oil and coal-fired plants that would otherwise be needed to meet regional energy demand. Although our analysis does not take any credit for this displacement, it means that KEC will help improve overall air quality in Connecticut and New England by reducing regional emissions from the electric generation sector as a whole.

Finally, KEC will use a continuous air emissions monitoring system which measures and records emission levels to confirm and demonstrate our ongoing compliance with all federal and state emission standards and programs. This data is reported regularly to the DEEP and is available to the public.
