Dear Neighbor,

As a part of our system-wide plan to enhance the safety of our pipelines, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas®) will be in your neighborhood performing a pipeline improvement project on Sepulveda Boulevard off the southbound 405 Moraga Freeway On/Off Ramp in the city of Los Angeles.

To perform this pipeline improvement project safely, the operation will require weekend work activity on the following weekends.

Saturday, September 9, 2017 and Sunday, September 10, 2017 – Work Hours: 7am – 7pm

Saturday, September 16, 2017 and Sunday, September 17, 2017 – Work Hours: 7am – 7pm

Saturday, September 23, 2017 and Sunday, September 24, 2017 – Work Hours: 7am – 7pm

Saturday, November 18, 2017 – Work Hours: 7am – 7pm

Saturday, December 2, 2017 – Work Hours: 7am – 7pm

Saturday, December 19, 2017 – Work Hours: 7am – 7pm

Night Work is expected to initiate Monday, September 25, 2017 – Work Hours: 10pm – 6pm

Vehicular traffic will be reduced to one lane on both southbound and northbound lanes on Sepulveda Boulevard. Both 405 freeway on/off ramps on Moraga will be completely closed during work hours mentioned above. During this time, you will hear construction noise. We encourage anyone who has concerns about the smell of gas to call us from a safe location at **1-800-427-2200**. **We are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.**

Your gas service should continue without interruption. If that changes, a SoCalGas representative will contact you.

We apologize for any inconvenience you may experience while we perform this work and appreciate your patience and cooperation. This letter does not require any action on your part.
