



Environmental Policy

Purpose

The aim of this policy is to demonstrate Horley Lawn Tennis Club's commitment to ensuring that the environmental impact of the Club's operation are considered and those impacts mitigated to the maximum extent possible.

This policy is fully supported by the HORLEY LAWN TENNIS CLUB (HLTC) management committee ("the management committee"), which is responsible for the implementation and review of this policy.

Policy Statement

HLTC will:

- comply with or exceed all legislative requirements for environmental protection
- ensure that the design and construction of the replacement clubhouse are such as to minimise environmental impact. In particular:
 - heating systems and lighting will be as efficient as possible
 - insulation will be optimised to minimise energy use
 - the construction contract will require maximum use of sustainable resources
- ensure that all recyclable waste (eg cardboard, metal and plastic tennis ball tubes, bottles (glass and plastic), drinks cans etc) is separated and recycled
- wherever possible ensure that recycled or recyclable products are purchased instead of those that are not
- promote among its members, guests and visitors recycling and re-use of waste materials
- regularly review all areas of operation for their impact on the environment and take mitigation action wherever possible
