### **PARK RANGER I**

This is a full-time position working 40 hours per week, which does require working a flexible schedule including weekends, holidays and evenings.

Duties and responsibilities are as follows:

This position will be assigned to patrol parks, trails and open space, interface with park users and program participants for oversight of rules compliance. This position will receive a limited commission as a Code Enforcement Officer through the Douglas County Sheriff's Office and wildland fire training through Littleton Fire and Rescue.

This position will take the lead in special events and promote environmental stewardship by developing and presenting outdoor education programs to adult and youth groups.

Applicants must have an Associate's degree in Parks, Recreation or Open Space management or related field, two years Park Ranger enforcement experience and the ability to present outdoor education programs. Combinations of education and experience will be considered. Applicants must also have an acceptable motor vehicle record.
