

Judy Estrin – Bio

Judy Estrin Chief Executive Officer, JLABS, LLC Judy Estrin is CEO of JLABS, LLC (formerly known as Packet Design Management Company, LLC) and author of *Closing the Innovation Gap*, published in 2008. She is also a member of the Board of Directors of KQED and The Medium Corporation and a founding advisor for PrimeMind. From January 2012 until March 2013 she also served as Executive Chairman of EventLive, Inc. and then as CEO from March 2013 until its acquisition by Yahoo in December 2013. Prior to cofounding Packet Design, in May 2000, Estrin was chief technology officer for Cisco Systems. Beginning in 1981 Estrin co- founded three other successful technology companies: Bridge Communications, Network Computing Devices, and Precept Software. In 1998 Cisco Systems acquired Precept, and she became Cisco's chief technology officer until April 2000. Estrin has been named three times to Fortune Magazine's list of 50 most powerful women in American business. She served on the boards of directors of The Walt Disney Company from 1998 until 2014, FedEx Corporation from 1989 through 2010, Sun Microsystems from 1995 through 2003 and Rockwell Corporation from 1994 through 1998. She holds a B.S. degree in math and computer science from UCLA, and an M.S. in electrical engineering from Stanford University.
