Crisis Line Specialist

- Provide crisis intervention, assessment, crisis support, information, finding shelter, safety planning, and referrals on our 24-hour help line.
- Must be 18+ years old and complete required training.

Childcare Volunteer

- Provide care for children while their mothers are attending Rivers of Hope support groups.
- Support groups are held in Buffalo every other Wednesday and Elk River every other Tuesday in the evening.
- Must be 18+ years old and complete brief training.

Court Watch Advocate

- Attend criminal court hearings.
- Observe and record court proceeding outcomes on cases concerning domestic violence in Wright and Sherburne counties.
- Must be 18+ years old, be available during regular business hours and complete required trainings.

Special Events

- Assist Rivers of Hope in preparing for special public events which include our Hope Gala (October) and assisting with fundraising.
- Must be 18+ years old.

Office Support

- Perform various office tasks including, but not limited to: answering office phones, copying, compiling newsletters, preparing items for mailings, shredding documents, organizing donations, and computer projects.
- Must be 18+ years old and complete brief training.

Speaker's Bureau

- Represent Rivers of Hope in the community. Present at community education speaking engagements or exhibit at local events/fairs.
- Must be 18+ years old and complete required training.
