One \$250 Best Portfolio Award and \$250 in additional awards will be given to students graduating during 2017 from ESD 123 or Tri-City area high schools. These awards will be presented at the discretion of the judges and in recognition of the student's accomplishments in the visual arts during his/her school years.

**Rules:**

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior of a Greater Tri-Cities area high school.
2. Applicant must deliver an application and portfolio of his/her works to the Allied Arts Association Scholarship Committee on either **April 21 or 22, 2017 (Friday or Saturday, 10 to 5)** at the Gallery, 89 Lee Blvd., Richland WA.
3. Each portfolio must include an itemized list and explanation of work item and have the following information plainly printed on the back upper right hand corner of each piece of two dimension work and securely attached to three dimension work.  
**APPLICANT'S NAME, ADDRESS, BEST PHONE CONTACT, NAME OF HIGH SCHOOL**
4. The portfolio submitted must contain five, but no more than ten pieces of art. Art may be in more than one medium. Portfolio pieces need not be matted when submitted for judging. Photographs may be used for three dimensional work or exceptionally large pieces of flat work only; however, original art is preferred. Work submitted by photo or on CD must include a clearly written explanation of each piece. **ANY STUDENT SUBMITTING MORE THAN 10 PIECES WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE VISUAL AWARD.**
5. The applicant must submit a one page typed resume with the portfolio.
6. The Award recipient agrees to exhibit his/her work in the gallery at the Annual Allied Arts Scholarship and Award Show during the period **May 2 to 26, 2017**. Award recipients are requested to be present at the show's **reception on Sunday, May 7, 2017 from 1 to 3**. Work selected for show by judges must be prepared to hang, i.e. matted and mounted. Framed work must be wired for hanging.
7. Student work selected for show should be **picked up on Friday or Saturday May 26 or 27, 2017**. A student whose work is not selected for show will be notified to pick up their work as soon as judging is completed.

*Board members and their immediate families are not eligible to receive cash awards or scholarships.*
