

LOCAL FAVORITES!

Leavenworth National Fish Hatchery

Icicle Creek Nature Trail is a one-mile loop trail that is a part of the Cascade Loop of the Audubon Society's Great Washington State Birding Trail. Self-guided tour flyers are available. Please park outside the main entry gate after 2 p.m.

Icicle Gorge Nature Loop

A popular trail in the Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest, ideal for families, trail runners, beginner hikers, bird enthusiasts, and those looking to take a nice long walk. A day pass is available for \$5 (cash or check) from the wooden kiosk at the trailhead.

Lake Wenatchee

Includes several units, but the south entrance is the best for birding. A Discover Pass, which can be self-issued at the site, is required. A diverse assortment of waterfowl, shorebirds, migratory and resident passerines, woodpeckers, and raptors.

Mountain Home Preserve

The main loop follows Mountain Home Road to the top of a saddle and has great views of Wedge Mountain and the Enchantments. The wildflowers and song birds are incredible and the views looking up the Icicle and down on the valley from the ridge are unbeatable.

Blackbird Island

A 2 mile moderately trafficked loop trail located near Leavenworth, Washington that features a river and is good for all skill levels. Enjoy the sounds of birds calling, fish jumping, and plenty of informative signs telling the history of the area.

Barn Beach Reserve

Located in a spectacular setting that features accessible walking trails and panoramic views of the Wenatchee River. Pick up one of our eBird species checklist and map at the kiosk outside of the River Haus.

Icicle Ridge

Marvel at the huge variety of wildflowers and wildlife. It is fascinating to see the changes in the types of flowers and their stage of blooming as you gain elevation. The trail is well laid out, switch-backing up the steep slope, a dirt trail with occasional rocks or roots.

Sauer's Mountain

Located near Peshastin, Washington, this trail features beautiful wild flowers and is primarily used for hiking and trail running. Views of the Enchantments are stunning.

Ski Hill

The Ski Hill 'trails' are popular places to walk, run, and mountain bike for three season use. Hike up the For the Boys trail for a spectacular view of Leavenworth.




