HEALTHCARE LEADERS CONVENE TO SHARE INNOVATIONS THAT CAN TRANSFORM PATIENT CARE



The Pediatric Innovation Leadership Forum and the National Healthcare Innovation Summit brought together over 250 government officials, policy leaders, healthcare executives, and innovation officers to promote innovation within pediatric healthcare, and identify strategies to improve health care delivery in the US and abroad.

Leaders representing 27 pediatric hospitals around the world convened at the Pediatric Innovation Leadership Forum to discuss challenges and solutions to improve pediatric care. Through a series of roundtable discussions, workshops, and individual presentations, professionals were able to exchange ideas and form working groups to continue the dialogue regarding pediatric healthcare innovation. IPI MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

IPI provides a tiered membership structure for hospitals, health systems and others involved in pediatric innovation:

Clinical Innovation Catalyst Training Program Member

Members of the Clinical Innovation Catalyst Program may enlist up to two clinicians in the program, where they will acquire the skills to serve as innovation catalysts in their pediatric healthcare center.

Participating hospitals have access to IPI's consulting services on a preferred pricing basis. These members are also entitled to an observer seat on the Consortium Executive Council, a group of advisors that provide business and clinical guidance to IPI's management team and Board of Directors. In addition, organizations will receive two invitations to IPI's annual meeting, as well as recognition in IPI's quarterly newsletter.

General Affiliate Member

General affiliate members are entitled to two project assessments, as well as discounts on IPI's consulting services. These members will receive one invitation to IPI's annual meeting, recognition on IPI's website, and other public relations opportunities.

Founders

As a founding member of IPI, organizations have access to all of IPI's consulting services and are provided with a seat on the Clinical Innovation Catalyst Program steering committee. Needs Analysis

IPI assists the hospital's clinical and executive leadership in qualifying and selecting a performance improvement area or hospital acquired condition to serve as a target for a hospital innovation program.

On-site Innovation Workshops

IPI team members introduce hospital staff and stakeholders to principles of product innovation, intellectual property, brainstorming, as well as product and business development planning.

IPI Pediatric Device Hub

Clinicians at participating hospitals have access to a database to share evaluations and tips for using current pediatric medical devices in relation to a targeted performance improvement area.

Project Assessment

IPI provides hospitals with a template for soliciting ideas from staff and will conduct a preliminary review/triage to determine the best next steps and resources for developing the innovation.

Opportunity Analysis

IPI develops a detailed opportunity analysis of clinical, technical, and market feasibility of selected innovations, including identification of product development costs, timeframe, and potential corporate partners.

Innovation Fund Development

IPI provides assistance to hospital leadership in organizing and administering a funding vehicle to support the organization's innovation program.
