ORDER

For good cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants Billy Hoffman and Virgil Griffith are hereby temporarily enjoined from:

1. revealing or discussing any signals to or from any Blackboard reader or any Blackboard transaction processing system, that may have been captured;
2. revealing or discussing information about how any information is stored on any Blackboard card or reader, or on any Blackboard transaction processing system;
3. providing to others, or revealing or discussing any information relating to, any "drop-in compatible reader that will work with an existing RS-485 network";
4. releasing code to make a computer emulate any Blackboard reader or any Blackboard transaction processing system, as well as the hardware designs to make a drop in replacement for any Blackboard reader or any Blackboard transaction processing system; and
5. claiming any that either of them has any right, either explicitly or implicitly, to provide products or services that can legitimately be used or interfaced with a Blackboard product, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants Billy Hoffman and Virgil Griffith shall remove Blackboard's logo from their website, as well as any materials on their website that include any information set forth above, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the temporary restraining order shall remain in effect until a hearing is held on Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction, which shall be held on April 16, 2003. at 9:00 AM *
