## PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons are available for children and adults as follows:  
 Clay can be purchased for \$1.50/lb. Please call a least a day ahead to arrange a time with an instructor.

1 Student \$40/hr.  
 2 Students \$55/hr.

Add \$15 per additional student. Maximum is 4 students.

## MEMBERS

Adults with a solid working knowledge of clay and our studio procedures can apply to become studio members. Membership is \$125/mo. Members have 24 hour access to the studio, and are welcome at anytime, even during classes if space permits. Member can learn about kilns and glazes and sell their work in the gallery if it is approved and meets gallery standards.

## PRACTICE TIMES

Monday 10 - 9, Tuesday 6 - 9, Wednesday 10 - 9,  
 Thursday 10 - 6, Fri. & Sat. 10 - 5, Sunday 11 - 5  
 During class times, practice is limited to practice spaces  
 and the glaze room (if space permits).

## CLASS SIGN UP

Students currently enrolled in a class are given priority in enrolling in the upcoming class session before we sign up new students. Therefore we often put new students on a first come first serve waiting list until we know how many spaces will open in an upcoming class. If you are on the waiting list for a class and we contact you that a space has become available you must confirm your spot with us within 48 hours or we will contact the next person on the waiting list.

## CLASS MAKE-UP

Most classes meet once a week for seven weeks. If you can not attend a class due to illness or scheduling problems you may make up the class on another day of the week with permission of the instructor. There is often an open make-up class at the end of the session on the first Wednesday after classes are completed from 6 - 9pm. Students are allowed one make-up class per session. Please contact Mike if you extenuating circumstances that require you to miss many classes.
