

The Samburu Project's WALK FOR WATER is an an annual fundraising event to grow awareness of the worldwide water crisis and to provide access to clean water in Kenya.

The Hermosa Beach event traditionally includes 300 walkers who participate in a 4-mile walk or run on the Hermosa Beach strand between the Hermosa and Manhattan Beach Piers. Walkers are sponsored by friends and family to meet a minimum, personal fundraising goal of at least \$100. A celebratory pancake breakfast at American Junkie restaurant follows, with entertainment, games, raffle and prizes for top fundraisers.
