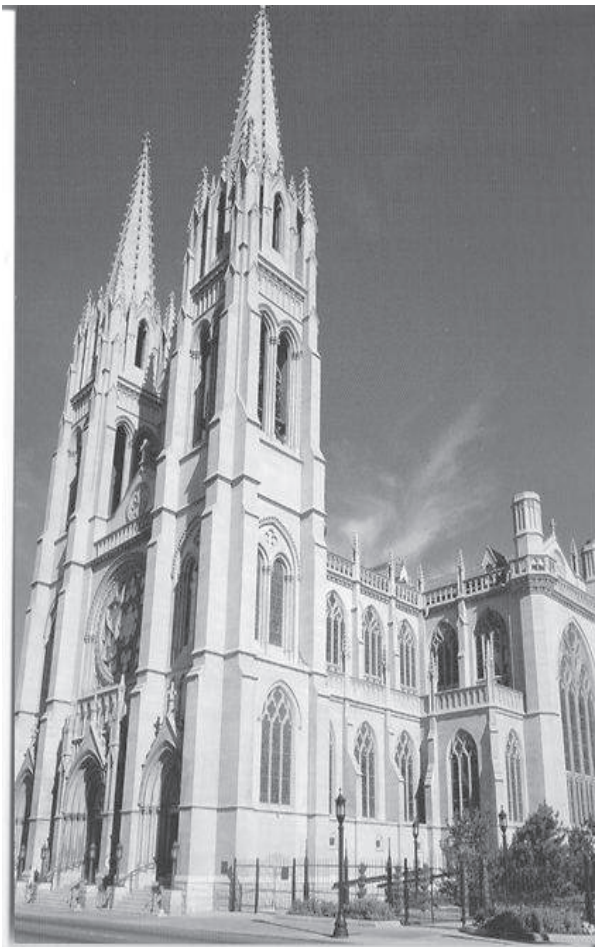

Adult Religious Education for Lent

Stage 2 of Fr. Michael Gaitley's Hearts Afire Program: Wisdom and the Works of Mercy. What is the key to wisdom?

Last year we began Fr. Gaitley's **Hearts Afire** program of self-directed retreats with the two books and companion videos of Stage 1: *33 Days to Morning Glory* and *Consoling the Heart of Jesus*. We continue our adult formation program this Lent with Stage 2 and the book, *The One Thing is Three*. The first of the ten sessions will begin after weekend Masses beginning the weekend of 18-19 February. If you would like to participate, please go to the Cathedral Room after Mass. Books will be available free of charge. The videos run 35 minutes with 15 minutes for Q and A afterwards. The program lasts approximately one hour and runs February 18th until April 29-30. Please be aware that completing Stage 1 is not a requirement for participating in Stage 2.
