PAINT HAMMONTON: 9th Annual Plein-Air Event

Saturday, May 6, 2017

The Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University and the Hammonton Arts District are excited to announce that applications are now being accepted for the 9th Annual Plein-Air Event: *Paint Hammonton*. This painting event is widely anticipated and has previously attracted artists from Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, and Virginia in addition to many talented local New Jersey artists. The event takes place on Saturday, May 6. Painters set up their easels at locations of their choice all around town to capture the effects of natural light, quickly painting a scene before it's gone. Judging this year's competition is award winning artist and curator Philip J. Carroll of the Perkins Center for the Arts in Moorestown and their gallery in Collingswood, New Jersey.

\$2,000 in cash awards will be awarded and all of the paintings created during the event will be included in an exhibition that starts that evening and runs through July 30 at the Noyes Gallery at Stockton University's Kramer Hall in downtown Hammonton at 30 Front Street. All artists ages 18 and up are welcome to apply. Once accepted, the registration fee is \$30. The deadline to send in the email application for the competition is April 1, 2017. Artists will be notified of acceptance into the competition on April 7 via email.

Philip J. Carroll is a professional artist and has been the Curator of Exhibitions from 2009 to the present for the Perkins Center for the Arts in Moorestown and their Gallery in Collingswood, New Jersey. He grew up in Haddonfield, NJ and lives with his family in Collingswood where he has been a long time resident. He teaches painting for Perkins Center for the Arts in Moorestown. Mr. Carroll is a 1984 graduate of the Pennsylvania Academy of The Fine Arts, Philadelphia, and studied art history at The University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia.

Carroll's paintings can be found in the collections of The Philadelphia Museum of Art; Price Waterhouse, Philadelphia, PA; Stedman Art Gallery, Rutgers University, Camden, NJ; McGraw Hill Companies, New York City; and many private collections throughout the United States and abroad.

Recent group exhibitions include the Monmouth Museum, Monmouth NJ in 2016, Artists of Yardley, Yardley, PA in 2016 and SJ Waterways exhibition, Perkins Center for the Arts Gallery Annex Collingswood, NJ in 2016. He has had one person exhibitions of his paintings at Warm Springs Gallery, VA in 2011, Des Champs Gallery in Lambertville, NJ in 2009, and the Monmouth Museum in 2007.

Recent group exhibitions include The Monmouth Museum in March 2016; Medford Art Center in 2013; Trenton City Museum; Ellarslie Open 2010; Artists House Gallery, Philadelphia, PA in 2013; The Mainline Center for the Arts, 2009; and the Deschamps Gallery in Lambertville, 2007-2011.

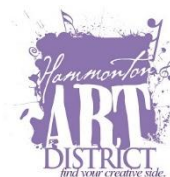
