To Apply:

- Applicants must complete the **General Information** below
- Artists creating work in a variety of media are encouraged to apply, including: painting, sculpture, prints, photography, jewelry, ceramics, wood, furniture, glass, accessories, children's items, etc.
- Must include a brief artist statement
- Must include 5 digital images of your original works that have been created in the past 2 years. **Any CDs submitted will not be returned.**
