A Spectacular Ski-In, Ski-Out Penthouse in Colorado Is on the Market for \$3.4 Million

This ski-in, ski-out penthouse with modern interiors by [Rockwell Group](#) is one of the priciest units in Colorado's [Aspen](#)/Snowmass Village area to date. It's conveniently located at the Residences Viceroy Snowmass, right at the base of Snowmass Mountain. Spread across a single level, the open-plan interiors feature wood-plank flooring in the generous living-dining room, which has a fireplace, and the adjoining state-of-the-art kitchen with a peninsula bar. The master suite, one of three bedrooms, also has a fireplace. Two terraces make the most of the amazing mountain views all around, and the luxury [amenities](#) of the nearby Viceroy Snowmass resort, such as a full-service spa, a pool and fitness center, and a slopeside ski valet, are available to residents.
