Snowmass' Most Expensive Penthouse Just Hit The Slopes

One of the world's finest resort destinations just unveiled two of its most expensive penthouses, fit for entertaining both family ski escapes and serene getaways alike.

Just a stone's throw outside of Aspen, Colorado, The Residences Viceroy Snowmass is a ski-in/ski-out luxury condo-hotel. There's a \$5 million sticker on their four-bedroom unit, and the 3-bedroom is priced at \$3.4 million. Tucked between picturesque Rocky peaks, the resort is also surrounded by three national forests, the White River, Gunnison and Grand Mesa, replete with scenic activities for any season.





The 3,474-square-foot, four-bedroom unit sits on two levels, which may be used as adjoined or separate living quarters. The 2,169-square-foot, three-bedroom unit rests on one floor. Each expansive unit invites residents in with a hearty fireplace, plush sofas, and handcrafted wool rugs.

Warm hues and textured wall coverings pull the living room together in a cozy ambiance. Fine wood abounds the space, from the paneled flooring to the walnut table with starburst inlay – to the two full decks and balconies that provide mountainous views to marvel at.



While many pieces of furniture compliment the outdoor views, the sleek kitchen contrasts the naturalistic aesthetic with contemporary wood and glass display cabinetry. Bosch appliances line grey marble countertops, and a peninsula bar opens into the living area. A glass and bronze chandelier accents the room with a modern finesse.

The master bedrooms of both penthouses tout leather headboards equipped with saddle pockets for storage. The four-bedroom unit separates its master bedroom and bathroom on the upper level, in addition to boasting an additional fireplace and array of closets.
