- Visit to Six Mile Dam with special guide Michael Greenlee, ODNR Division of Wildlife, District Four: This may be one of the last opportunities to see the dam in its present state as it scheduled to be decommissioned end of 2018.
- Private tour led by the Army Corps of Engineers of the dramatic Art Deco Mohawk Dam built as part of the Muskingham Conservancy in 1937.
- Various canal structures including the one-of-a-kind Triple Lock at Roscoe Basin.
