

As BMUN LXVIII's only court-style committee, the International Court of Justice will follow custom procedure which reflects the nature of the committee. The following describes the DIFFERENCES between ICJ and standard BMUN procedure. Delegates should assume that ICJ committee procedure will follow standard BMUN procedure OTHER than the specified changes listed below.

Opening Debate

- The ICJ will not use the traditional Speaker's List as the default option for committee. Committee will open with a *mandatory* Speaker's List organized by country in alphabetical order. Each delegate will briefly outline their initial rulings for the committee; this is intended to spark debate. Once this Speaker's List is completed, committee will NOT revert to the Speaker's List again.
- The ICJ will run in perpetual moderated/unmoderated caucus, culminating in formal caucus and voting bloc once verdicts have been completed.

Witnesses

- The ICJ will feature testimony of pertinent witnesses from both sides of the case. Delegates will be permitted to question witnesses following their testimony for a limited period of time.

Verdicts

- Verdicts will NOT be written in a typical resolution format. We will review the format of verdicts at the start of committee.
