## Tzedek DC's 2019 Eat Well, Do Justice: Celebrity Chef Knish Knockout!: A Recap

On September 23, 2019, an inspiring group of nearly 400 people celebrated Tzedek DC's mission at *Eat Well, Do Justice: Celebrity Chef Knish Knockout!* We ate well and did justice, raising over \$200,000 to fund Tzedek DC's work safeguarding the rights of low-income DC residents facing debt-related crises.

Attendees heard from Tzedek DC leadership and from Tzedek DC client Ms. Glenda Richmond, a long-time DC resident, UDC alum, and grandmother who shared her inspiring story. Glenda recounted her struggles with debt and an especially difficult six month period of homelessness, and how even when she had a job and income once again after that, how debt collectors had contacted her relentlessly for her decades-old student loan. She recalled: "I started receiving constant letters and calls from debt collectors. I felt like I was drowning." She shared how Tzedek DC assisted her in securing a reduced monthly debt payment obligation, one her cash flow can handle. She also powerfully reminded us all of the importance of coming together in these times, invoking the teaching of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.: "we may have all came on different ships, but we're in the same boat now."



Attendees at the event, held at UDC's Student Center, feasted on a delicious variety of knishes created and donated by five talented and generous DC-area chefs recruited by honorary event chair **Bonnie Benwick**.
