Recalling on long-term mutual cooperation based on 18th Article of African Union Convention on Preventing and Combating Corruption

Noting the necessity of cooperation of our countries because of previous conflicts and presence of reciprocally deficient resources

Stressing the fact of existing corruption in such spheres as juridical in Kenya, party system in China, mining of the mineral resources in Nigeria

1. *Calls for* making system more transparent by giving full acces to records of incomes of institutions, authorities, government to the internet resource due to the bill so every person can compare official income with real property
2. *Expresses* its appreciation to project experience of China on African countries but with some changes, namely to remove death penalty with full-life imprisonment
3. *Offers* to integrate special anti-corruption course into school program in Kenya, China, and Nigeria
4. *Suggests* implementing independent jury into court process in Kenya, China, and Nigeria
5. *Approves* creating a Ministry of the Mineral Resources Mining controlled by the UN in Kenya, Nigeria, and China
