Topic: Creation of Framework and Goals for Sustainable Development

The Economic and Social Council,

Alarmed by low electricity supply and usage of non-renewable resources to create energy,

Deeply concerned about degeneration of available resources and possibility of its disappearing,

Observing topsoil depletion getting worse,

Fully aware that only 3% of all Earth' water is drinkable and only 1% is available for mankind to use, also that this reserve is rapidly decreasing,

Taking into consideration deforestation around the globe,

Keeping in mind the problem of desertification which is related to every country, but in different scales,

1. *Reminds* member States that rational usage of nature resources could be a possible solution to reduce starvation of them and help us keep it longer on the Earth;
2. *Calls upon* countries to work to replace non-renewable resources with alternative ones;
3. *Encourages* member States to create an eco-friendly appliance to produce energy according to location: for example, in Egypt and Syria – lenses, which will play the role in distributing solar photons, in UK – windmills, which will direct air masses and collect wind power;
4. *Emphasizes* that crop rotation is “the successive planting of different crops on the same land to improve soil fertility and help control insects and diseases.” and it’s beneficial in several ways, mostly because it is chemical-free, crop rotation has been proven to maximize the growth potential of land, while also preventing disease and insects in the soil;
5. *Recommends* to use crop rotation not only for benefit of commercial farmers, but also as an aid to those who garden at home;
6. *Acknowledges* that tree planting can reverse desertification by supporting the earth as plant life grows its roots into the sand, and helps to create a cycle of nutrients that nourish the soil,
7. *Draws attention to* deforestation a pointless in the meaning of getting material, because instead of this people can use alternative sources, synthetic or re-used wood,

8. *Express* hope that wastewater management can be used by any country as a way to reduce water consumption and pollution.
