Topic: The Refugees of the Dadaab Refugee Complex in Kenya

The Human Rights Council,

Stressing the fact that Kenya is going to close refugee camp Dadaab and 300.000 of refugees will lose their shelter,

Drawing attention to financial issues with repatriation of Dadaab refugees,

Noting the issue to ensure the safe, dignified and sustainable return to territories of Somali and South Sudan,

1. *Calls for* supporting countries to collaborate together to create a fund to raise the resources required for repatriation of Somalia refugees,
2. *Urges* the governments of Kenya and Somalia to guarantee implement of tripartite agreement between Kenya, Somalia and UNHCR,
3. *Encourages* member States to form a group of independent volunteers that will look after repatriation process and keeping it transparent,
4. *Requests* that countries provide to the refugees the whole spectrum of basic human rights and needs,
5. *Urges* Somalian government to build housing and infrastructure for refugees in Jubaland, Somalia,
6. *Approves* the creation of a committee that will help refugees to integrate in Somalian society.
