Rationale

The present and future health of pupils of Napier Central School is paramount in this issue. The school is an environment free from tobacco smoke and free from models of people who smoke.

Purpose

- To provide a healthy environment for pupils and staff that is smoke free.
- To ensure that models of smoking are not presented to the children at school.

Guidelines

1. Smoking is not permitted in any school building or on school grounds, at any time.
2. Parents will be made aware of this policy through newsletters and signs will be posted in the Administration area.
3. The School Health Programme will include information on the dangers of smoking as part of the "Staying Healthy" theme.
4. No smoking will be permitted at functions held in the Napier Central School hall.

Conclusions

Through the provision of a smoke free environment, and through its health and physical education programme, Napier Central School will promote the importance of not smoking, and the benefits of breathing clean air.
