The 3rd Annual Eastern Sierra History Conference seeks to enhance awareness, enrich knowledge, and generate recognition of the diverse and rich heritage of the Eastern Sierra region. We are asking for presentations on the history and culture of the Eastern Sierra, the contiguous geographic areas of Inyo and Mono counties, along with other factual recordings, studies or research that may have taken place outside of the region, but is significant to Eastern Sierra history. Selected presenters will have their papers published both electronically and written in the conference proceedings following the conference.

The Conference will be comprised of a keynote speaker and speakers on Friday and Saturday. During the morning sessions presenters will have 40 minutes to speak with 10 minutes for question and answer. Afternoon sessions will be 30 minutes with 10 minutes for question and answer. There will also be a dinner on Saturday evening, with an opportunity for either a keynote speaker or like last year's event in which we had local authors and historians present.
