CYO ATHLETICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (AAC)

The Athletics Advisory Committee (AAC) is a consultative body made up of head commissioners from each youth sports committee and at-large members whose primary function is to work in conjunction with the staff of CYO Athletics to develop its strategic vision in implementing a program of sports as ministry. As is necessary, they also review and provide insight and opinions on appeals from athletic directors of rulings by the staff of CYO Athletics or a sports committee. Appeals may be made to the AAC in regards to special requests, eligibility requests, and policy exceptions.

It is important to remember that these individuals and the sports commissioners are volunteers – giving of their time, expertise and passion to the community.

SPORTS COMMITTEES

It is the joint responsibility of CYO Athletics staff and existing committee members to recruit and select new members.

The committee for each sport will be responsible for:

- The rules and decisions on rule changes in keeping with the overall policy of CYO Athletics.
- Assisting in scheduling league and tournament games.
- On-site observations to ensure games are played within the framework of the philosophy of CYO Athletics and to enforce the unsportsmanlike conduct and playing time rules, as well as the code of conduct.
- Conducting the preseason coaches' meeting.
- Organizing and conducting technical clinics for coaches.
- Ruling on all properly submitted eligibility requests.
- Work with the Rules/Compliance/Officiating Committee to determine appropriate disciplinary action for all rule violations.

- Ruling on all matters not specifically treated above.

NOTE: Sport committee members have extensive experience with CYO Athletics, the sport in which they serve and/or a key constituency within the program. Decisions of a sport committee are made in consultation with staff of CYO Athletics who are ultimately responsible for the decisions being made. As noted above, some decisions at the level of the sport committee can be appealed to the CYO Athletics Advisory Committee.

RULES/COMPLIANCE/OFFICIATING COMMITTEE

The Rules/Compliance/Officiating Committee (RCO) is a consultative body made up of sports committee members during their sport season and at-large members who serve for the entire program year. The primary function is to work in conjunction with the staff of CYO Athletics to provide institutional context to the rules and policies as outlined in this manual, and in so doing assist staff and each sports committee in the initial decision making process for determining appropriate disciplinary action for rule violations. Under appropriate appeal, the RCO will review on behalf of participating programs a game protest, citation appeal, or any other form of suspension or ejection from a CYO Athletics contest. Decisions by the RCO are subject to review by the AAC and staff of CYO Athletics. The RCO will assist CYO Athletics staff, referee assignors and associations in ensuring all referees and officials are trained, evaluated and serving in a professional manner.
