

All I Really Need to Know I Learned in Kindergarten, a book by Robert Fulghum, was popular when I first got married.

Some dismiss this book of short essays as being too trite, simply irrelevant, and/or overly optimistic, but there is more than a kernel of truth to what Fulghum was trying to express.

There is a hope in the innocence of youth, there is the recognition that as adults we do, down deep, truly know what's important and want our children to learn these fundamentals too, and unfortunately there is also the bittersweet realization that as we grow older we begin to live in this tension between knowing what is right and the hypocrisy of our current existence where we ignore our own deep held and fundamental beliefs.

We are all children of God and, as such, God wants what is best for each and every one of us. And yet, for some reason we continually stumble through life ignoring the lessons that God sent his Son to teach us.

We ignore or forget that in our baptism we received the Holy Spirit and the promise that our sins are forgiven.

And we ignore or forget that the Holy Spirit remains with us today and is ever present to sustain us in our faith even as we fight the freely given gift of grace we were offered at the foot of the cross.

So, maybe Fulghum was not that far off the mark.

Maybe **“everything I really needed to know I [did] learn in kindergarten.”**

Maybe **“wisdom was not at the top of the graduate-school mountain, but there in the sandpile at Sunday School.”**

And maybe, just maybe, we need to be constantly reminded that, **“Whoever becomes humble like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.”**

So let us welcome the children around us today, learn from their innocence, and begin to rediscover the youthful joy we all once knew back in kindergarten, back in Sunday school, back on the sandpile, where we gladly called on the name of our Savior Jesus Christ.
