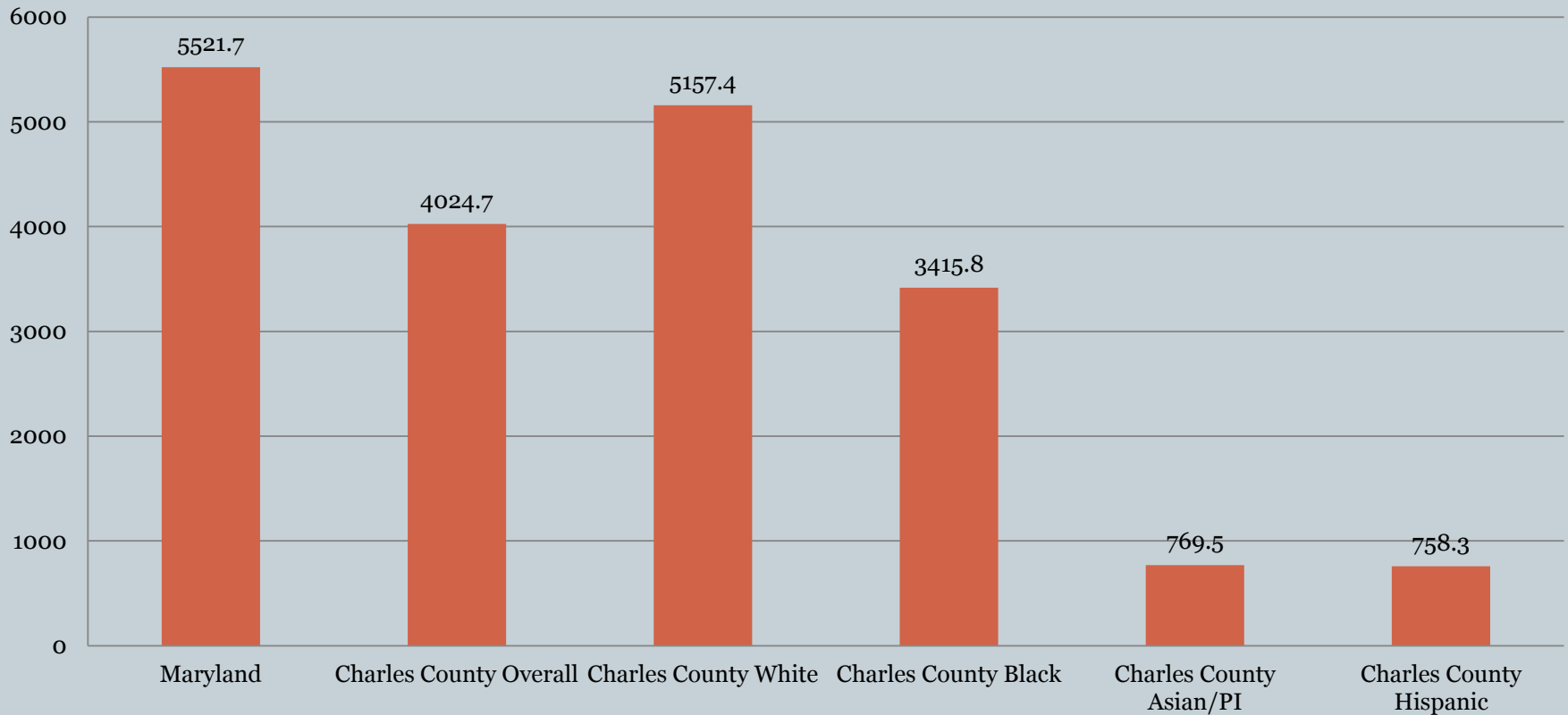

2011 Emergency Department Visit Rates for Behavioral Health Conditions (per 100,000 population)

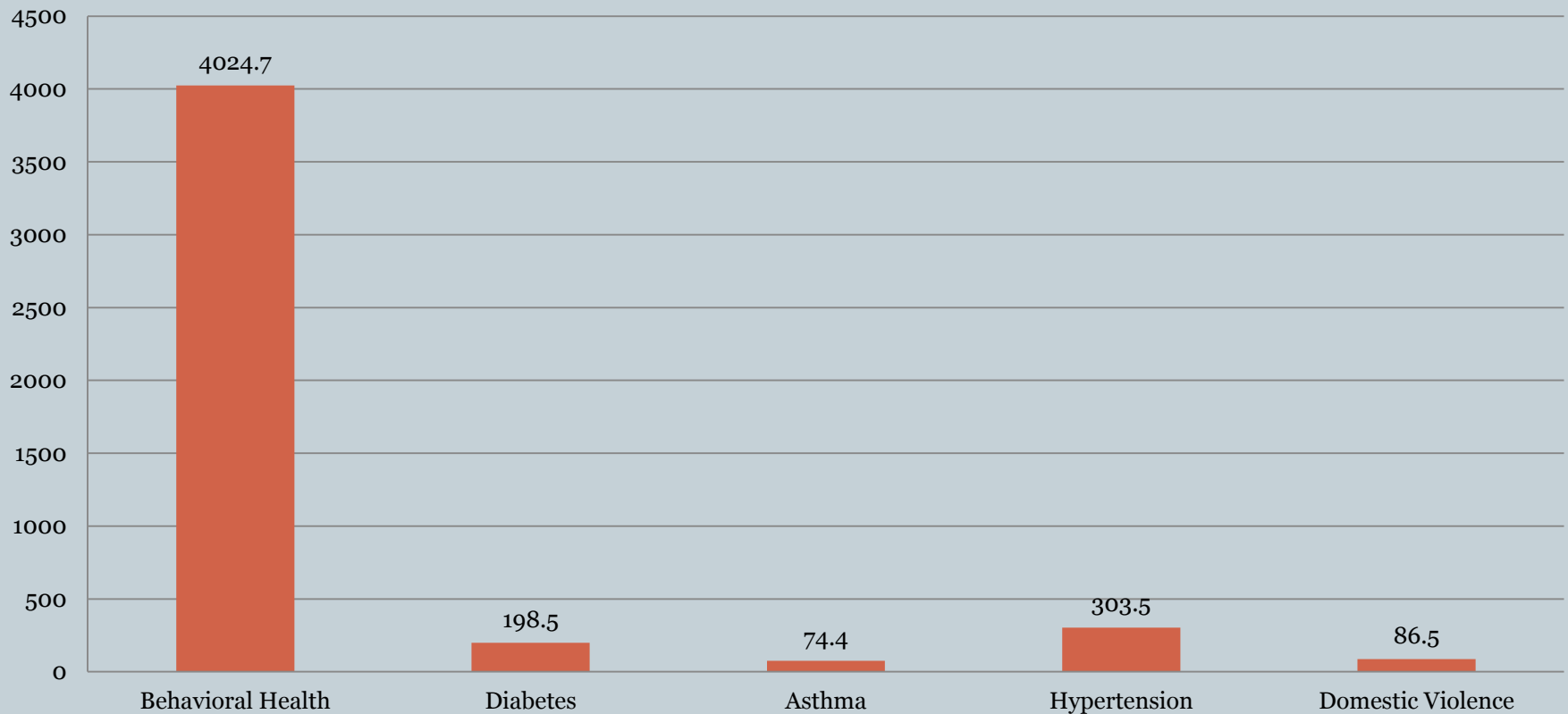

2011 Charles County Emergency Department Visit Rates by Health Condition (per 100,000 population)

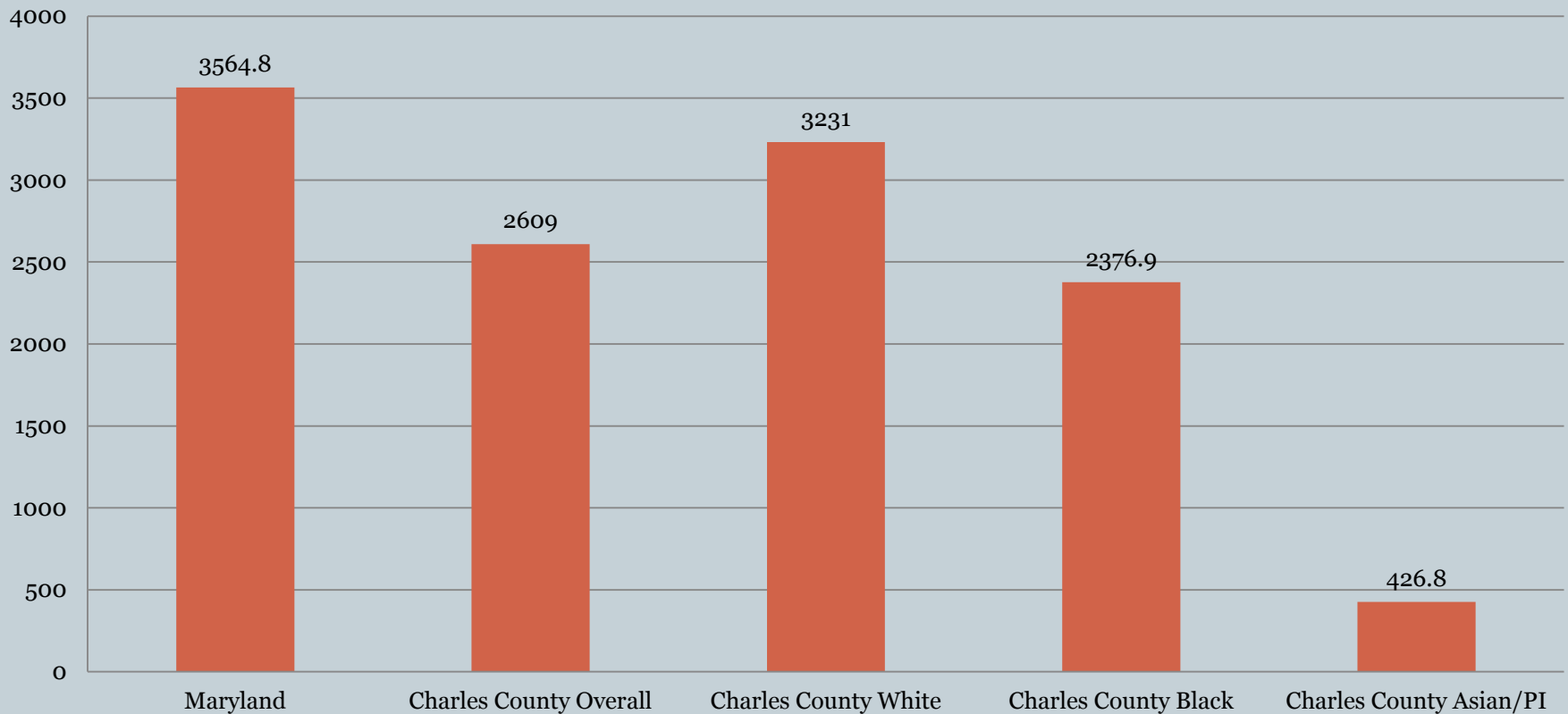

2012 Emergency Department Visit Rate for Mental Health Conditions (per 100,000 population)

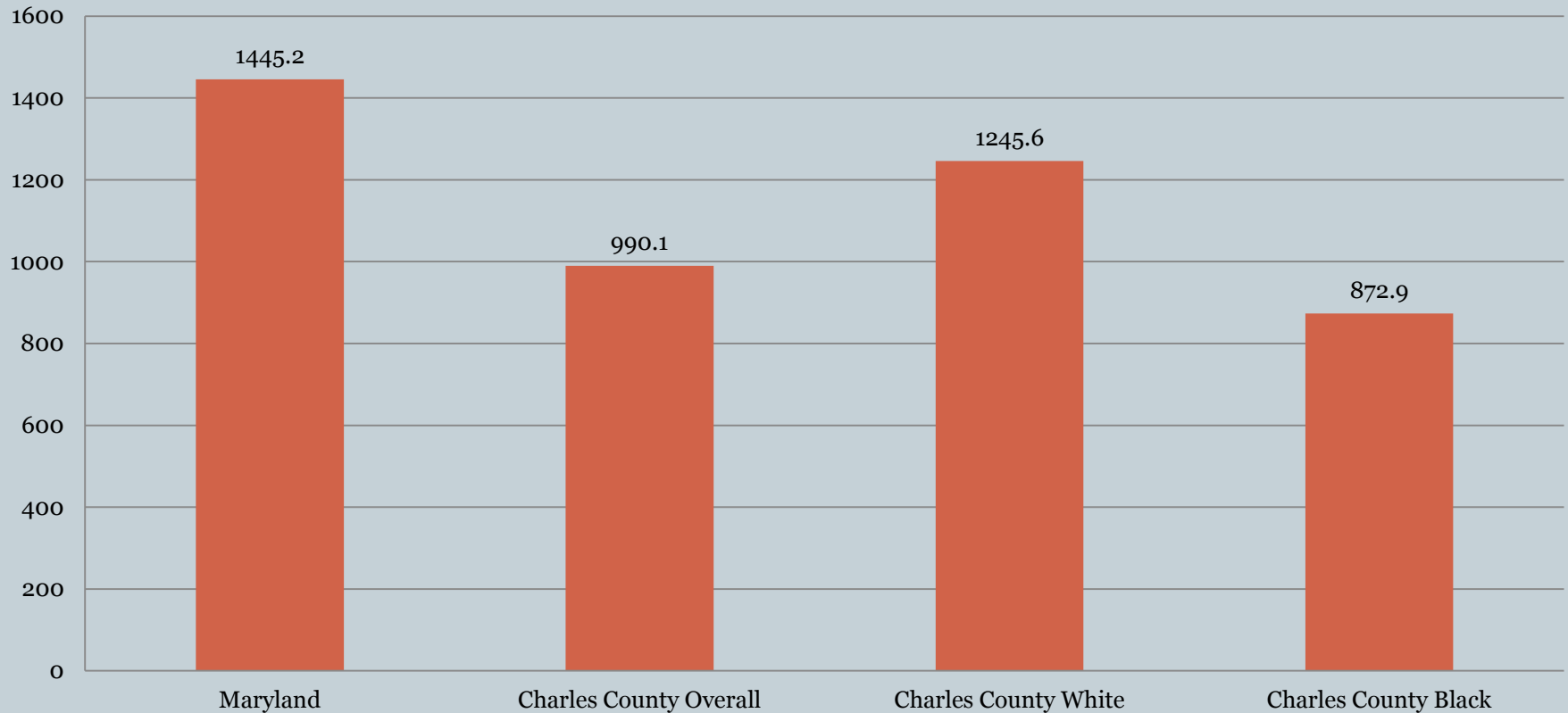

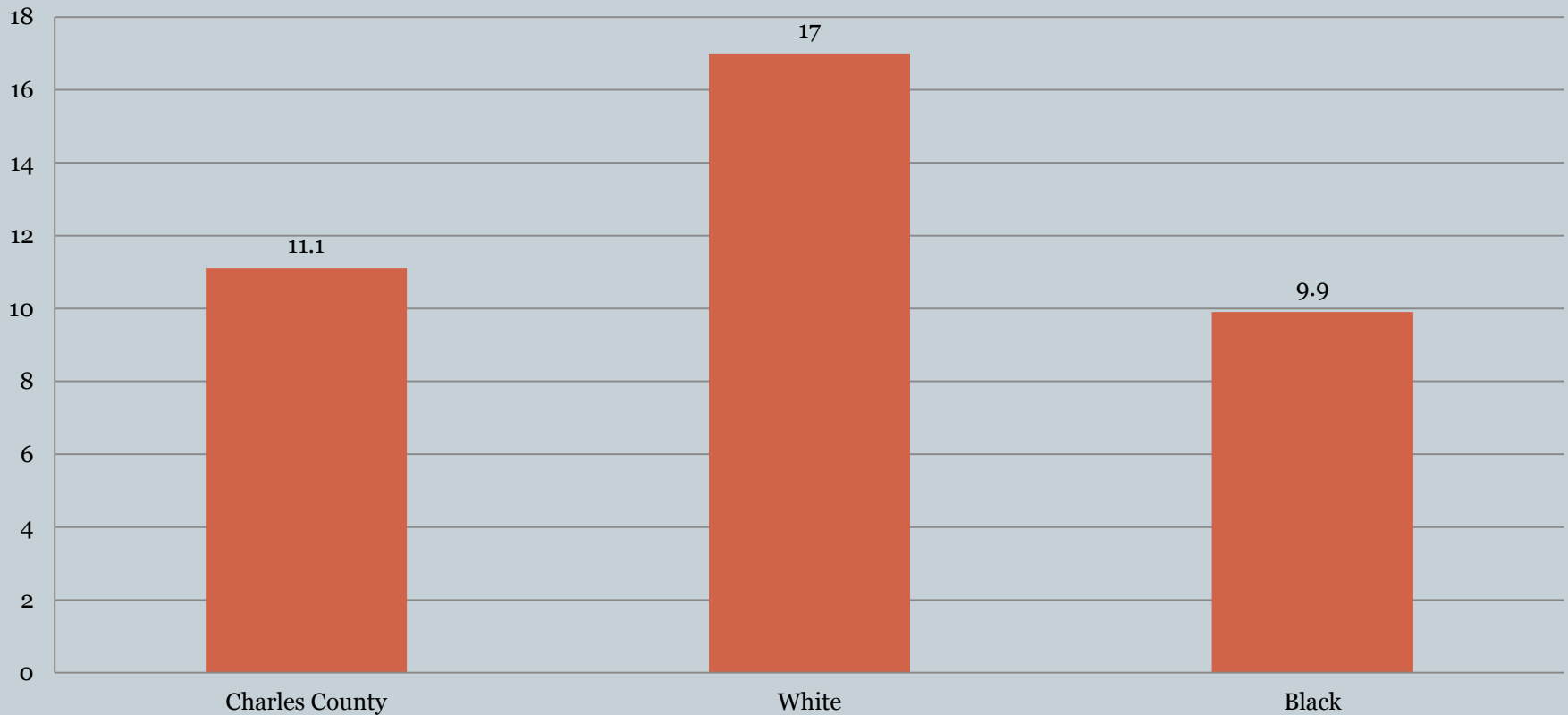

2009-2011 Charles County Drug-Induced Death Rates by Race

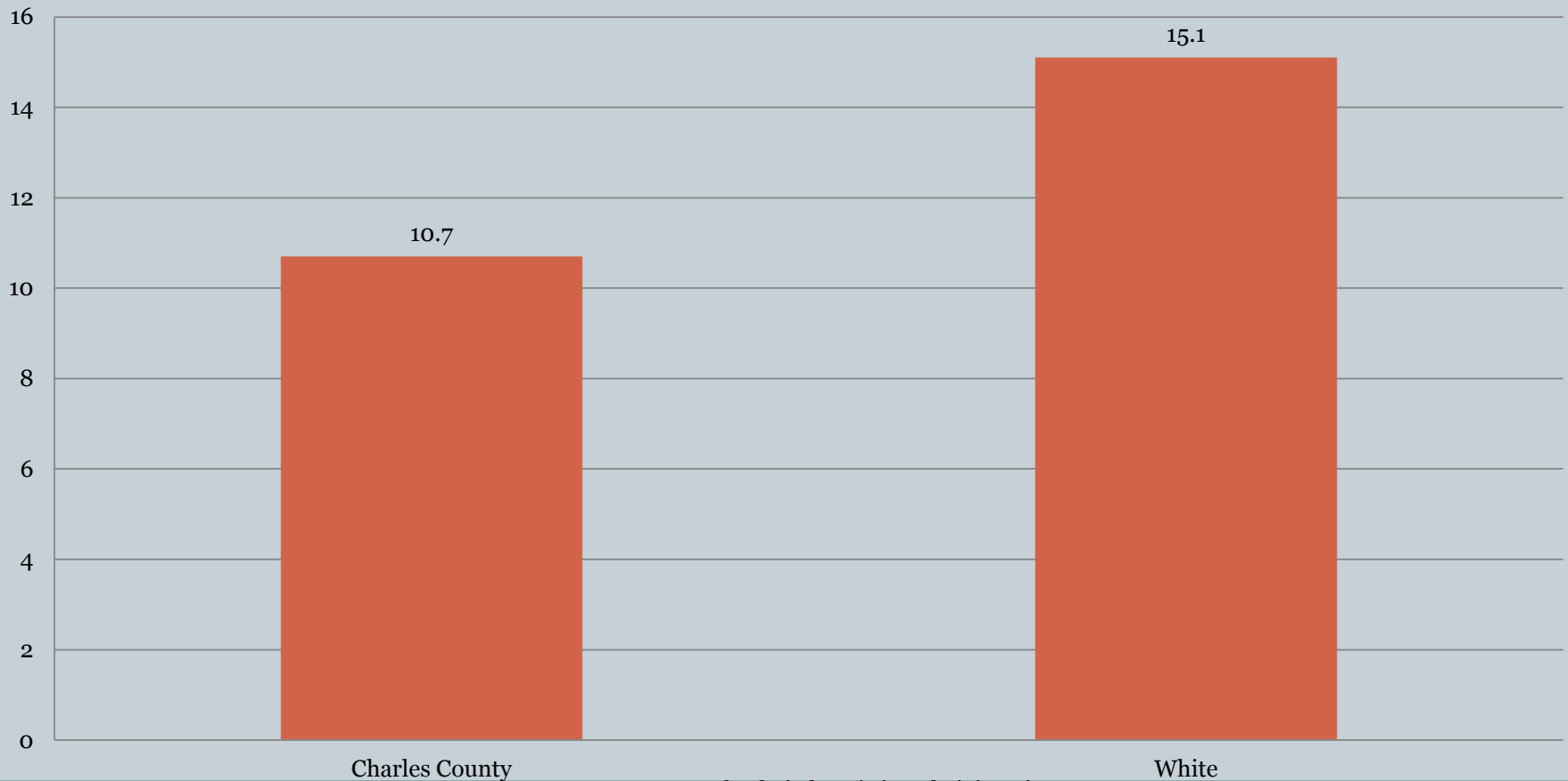

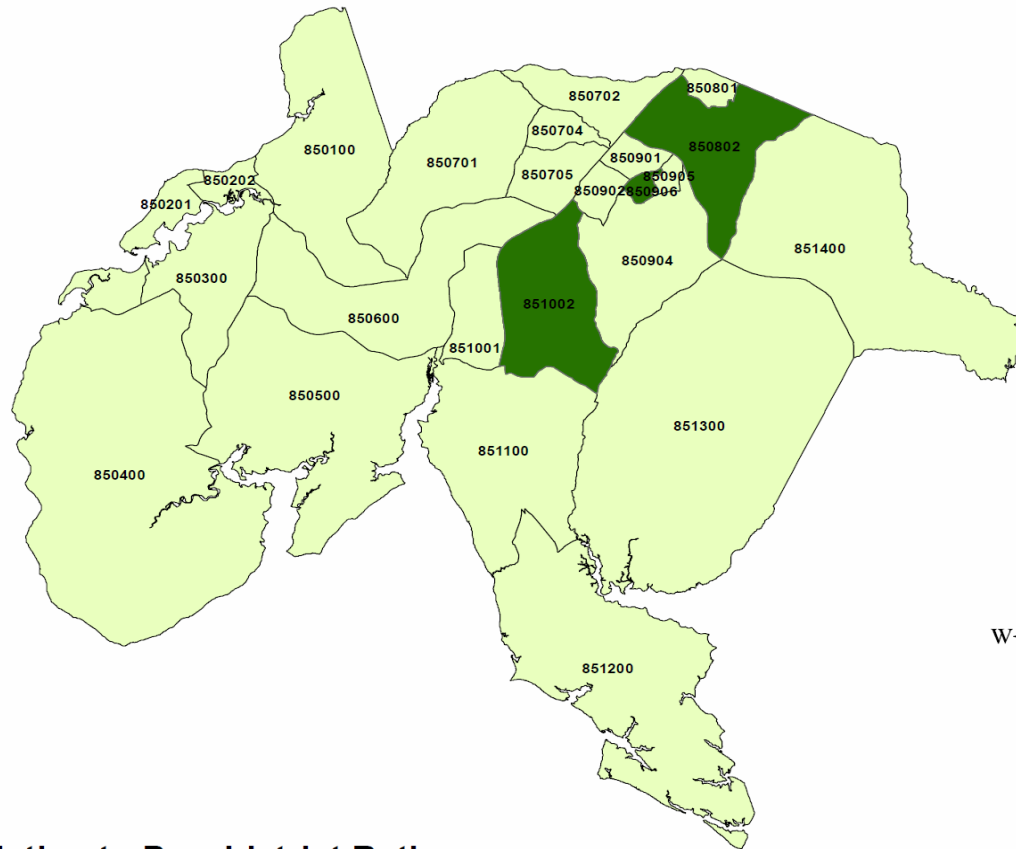

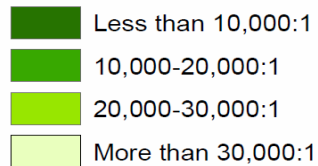


2012 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System Data	Charles County Prevalence (%)	Maryland Prevalence (%)
Chronic drinking (men more than 2 drinks and females 1 drink per day)	9.2%	5.5%
Binge drinking (men 5+ drinks and females 4+ drinks in one sitting)	18.3%	16.4%

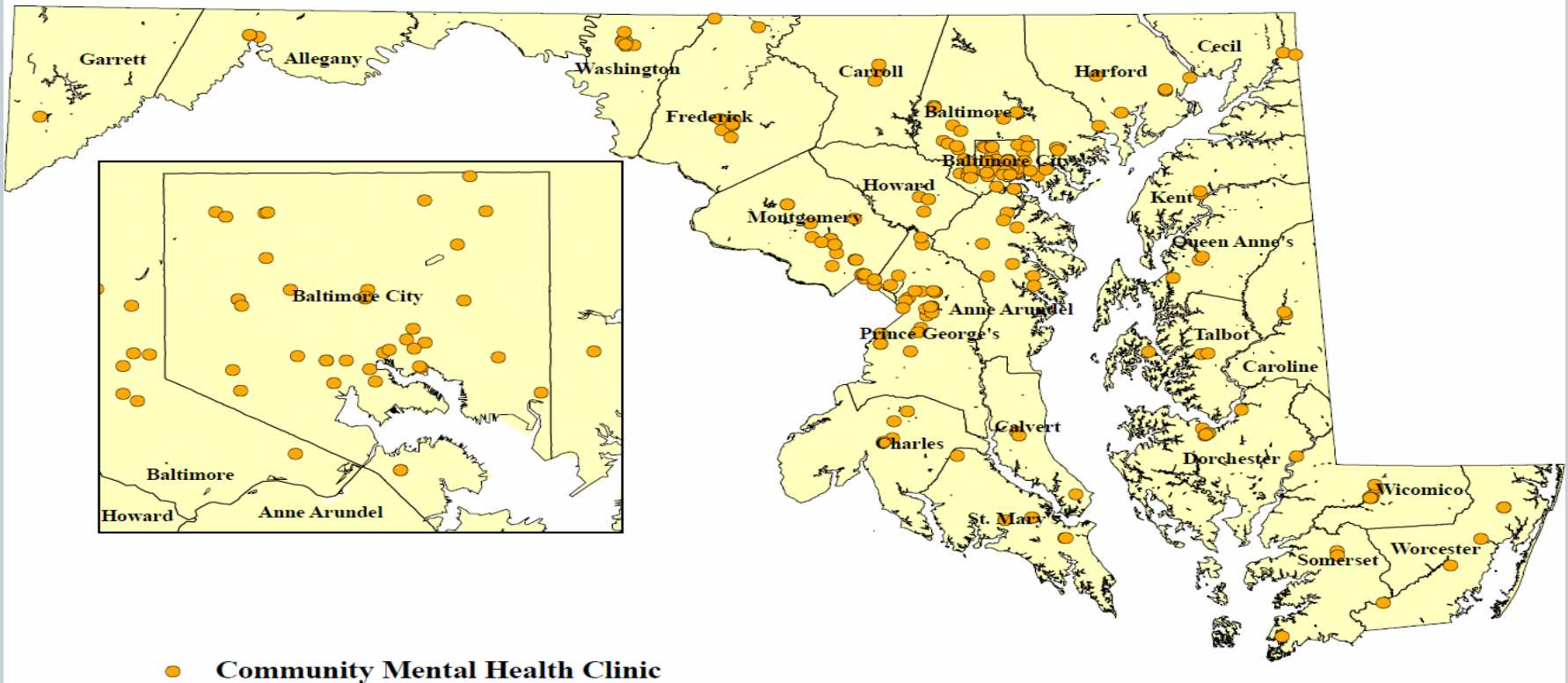
Population to Psychiatrist Ratios



Access to Community Mental Health Clinics



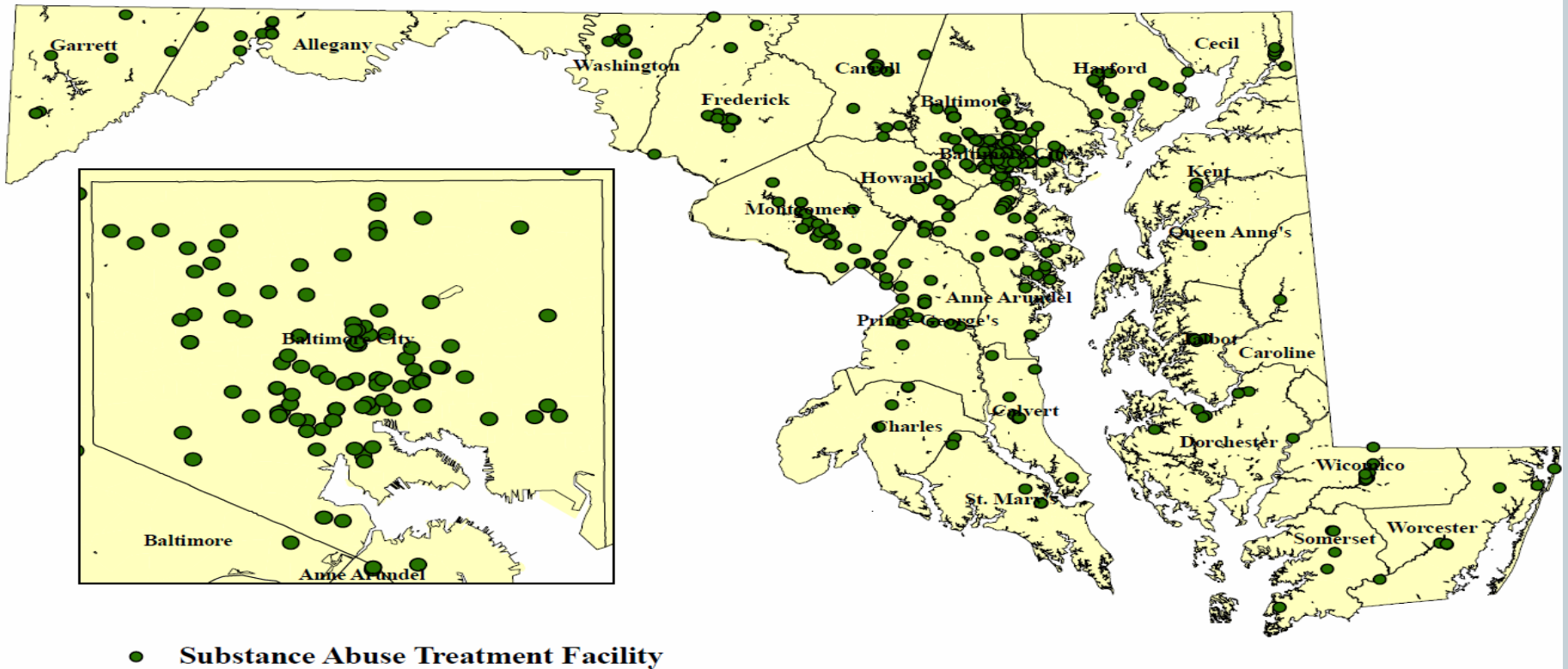
Maryland Community Mental Health Clinics
