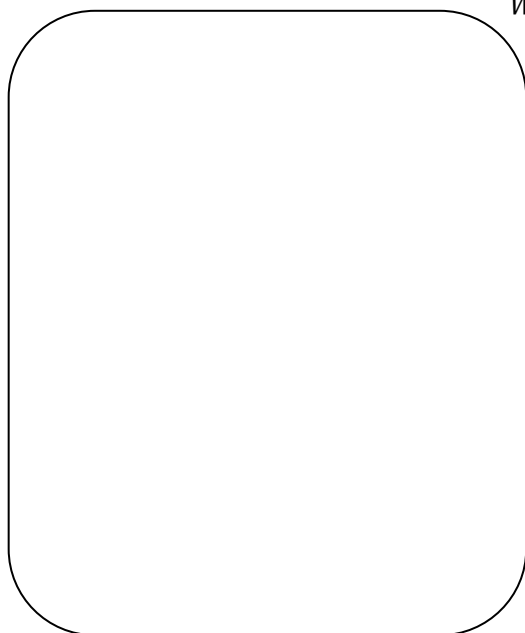
Add in a little Personality!
