

Position: Oncall/Support Instructor

Overview: Camp Wa-Ya is hiring for an Oncall/Logistical Support Instructor to work summer 2021 (June 28th through September 3rd). This position will support the Lead and/or Assistant Instructor in the delivery of lessons centered around STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) curriculum, in combination with indigenous practices and arts, outdoor adventure, and environmental stewardship. They will assist in the overall management of summer camp operations and the logistics that are necessary for the support and delivery of science & adventure-based activities. The Oncall/Logistical Support Instructor will also engage in a culturally integrated environment, where Wa-Ya's values of respect, diversity, equity, and inclusion are practiced. Logistical direction provided by engaged Board members. Camp is limited to 14 children between the ages of 6-13 years old, with a 7:1 student: teacher ratio.

Responsibilities:

- Provide logistical support, including but not limited to: organizing and delivering supplies, arranging and confirming field trip locations and speakers, transporting kayaks, loading and unloading kayaks onto a trailer, maintaining camp inventory & supplies, and assisting with the purchasing equipment/supplies.
- Serve as a substitute instructor when needed and deliver pre-planned curriculum and activities to students.
- Provide occasional on-site support for complex activities such as kayaking and/or rock climbing if needed, based on student abilities.
- Responsible for following camp policies and procedures and ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all participants at camp.
- Adhere to Wa-Ya COVID protocols, including proposal changes as state requirements evolve.
- Drive the WaYa vans (12- and 15-passenger).

Qualifications

- First Aid/CPR certified, Wilderness First Aid or Wilderness First Responder preferred.
- Valid driver's license, clean driving record, and ability to pass a background check.
- Available to work 7:30am - 6:00pm, Monday - Friday on an on-call basis, averaging 5-10 hours a week. Available to attend orientation June 23-25th.
- Knowledge, skills, and abilities to develop and deliver environmental science and/or outdoor curriculum to kids ages 6-13 years old.
- Knowledge, skills, and abilities to provide excellent logistical support and utilize critical thinking skills, problem-solving skills, prioritizing, and multitasking.
- Familiarity with local flora and fauna, STEAM activities, and adventure related activities including, but not limited to kayaking, rock climbing, hiking, and outdoor survival.
