CALL FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS
University of Central Oklahoma
October 16-17, 2017**

The Poster Session provides a forum for professional and students in OAHPERD to share their best practices and/or research in a poster format with other professionals in the field. The content must be the original work of the author(s). Poster proposals should be submitted in one of two categories:

- **Best practices** should describe innovative methods, programs, trainings, or projects implemented by the author(s).
- **Research posters** should describe the author's research that contributes to knowledge and ideas in health, physical education, recreation, and/or dance.

POSTER SUBMISSION/SELECTION CRITERIA:

Submissions are due by Friday, September 15, 2017

For each poster proposal, submit the following:

1. Category of proposal (indicate either **Best Practices** or **Research**)
2. Indicate **Professional** or **Student** submission (two student posters will be selected for a \$50 award each and will be published in OAHPERD's publication)
3. Title of the poster
4. Author and co-author(s) names and affiliation(s)
5. Abstract: Provide a 100 to 300-word abstract of the best practices or research which will be highlighted in your poster

All poster proposals will be peer-reviewed. Selection criteria will be based on originality, quality of scholarly research or application of best practices, and timeliness and relevance of the research/best practices.

Poster Session proposals should **be submitted by email attachment** to Kevin Fink, OAHPERD Research Council Chair (**kfink1@uco.edu**).

Poster Session applicants will be **notified by Friday, September 22, 2017** via email of proposal acceptance status.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER DISPLAY:

Each accepted poster must have a least one author at the conference to present the poster. The poster presenter must be present to engage in dialogue and address questions from conference participants during the Poster Session.

Typical poster size suggested for print is 3x4 feet. A floor easel will be provided to display the poster.

Your poster should include the title of your presentation, your name, affiliation, and any co-authors, as well as detailed information outlined in the poster proposal.
