

BREAKTHROUGH SUMMER CAMP

Lead Teacher

Lead a class of 15 - 20 native English-speaking and native Burmese-speaking students going into grades 1 - 5 through a five week summer enrichment program designed to strengthen academic skills and develop cross-cultural competencies in a faith-based environment.

Five weeks (June 26 - July 28), 18 hours per week (Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:30pm; Friday 8:30am - 10:30pm; no school July 3, 4), plus twelve additional hours for prep, training and wrap-up

Salary - \$18/hour

Requirements

- At least one year of teaching in his/her own classroom as the lead teacher
- Interest in developing innovative lessons with an emphasis on reading, writing and math
- Familiar with the unique challenges facing dual language students
- Excellent communication skills
- In agreement with the FBW statement of faith and mission/vision statements

Responsibilities

1. Create and implement curriculum that employs a variety of instructional methods and materials that engage the interests and abilities of the students.
2. Integrate a Biblical worldview into the curriculum.
3. Provide exposure to biliteracy and develop cross-cultural competencies for all students.
4. Set and evaluate academic objectives using Common Core Guidelines from the prior academic year.
5. Use computers, audiovisual aids and other equipment to supplement lessons.
6. Establish and maintain effective relationships with children, parents and staff.
7. Provide direction and guidance to teaching interns and classroom aides.
8. Practice positive, consistent discipline in the management of the classroom.
9. Attend a two-day orientation session prior to the start of the program and one day wrap-up.
10. Attend staff meetings on Fridays while kids are in VBS.
11. Inform the director in a timely manner if unable to fulfill any assigned duty. Prepare adequate information and materials for a substitute teacher.
