

Lil' Starts 2018 Gardeners CSA

What to expect

Subject to change. We will send your specific varietal list before planting time

MAIN SEASON:

April the ground is starting to warm up but temperatures are still cool especially at night making this the perfect time to transplant early cool season veggies. 2 Broccoli, 1 Cabbage, 1 Cauliflower, 6 Lettuce, 3 Kale, 2 Chard, 2 Mustard Greens, 4 Arugula, 12 peas, 6 Spinach, 1 pot bulb onions, 1 parsley, 1 chives, 1 scallions, 6 violas (\$45 value)

May is the time to transplant the hardiest of the heat lovers. 4 Tomatoes, 1 Zucchini, 2 Tomatillos, 1 Ground Cherries, 1 Summer Squash, 12 Beans, 2 Winter squash, 3 Basil, 3 Marigold, 4 Sunflowers, 3 Cosmos plus summer greens Magentaspreen, Orach, Lettuce. (\$50 value)

June is the time to plant finicky heat lover. 4 Peppers, 1 Eggplant, 2 Melons, 3 Cucumbers, 4 Zinnias plus lettuce, cilantro and dill. (\$45 value)

July is the time to plant your first fall crops. 2 Cabbage, 3 Broccoli, 2 Cauliflower, 4 Brussels Sprouts plus lettuce to keep you going (\$30 value)

MAIN SEASON SEEDS: these will be added to you monthly shares at the appropriate time for planting. French Breakfast Radish, Cherry Belle Radish, Carrots, Purple Haze Carrots, Red Beets, Golden Beets, Chioggia Beets

LATE SEASON:

August is your opportunity to plant fall, winter and early spring brassicas and to replenish your long season cold hardy greens. 3 Sprouting Broccoli, 2 Winter Cabbages, 2 Spring Cauliflower, 2 Collard Greens, 2 Kale, 2 Chard, 1 parsley (\$35 value)

September is the best time to get your quick growing greens in the ground for winter harvest. We recommend covering these beds with a tunnel or cloche. 12 lettuce, 6 arugula, 1 pot scallions, 6 spinach, 6 mustard greens plus crimson clover cover crop seed (\$25 value)

October mean garlic time! 1/2 lb. seed garlic plus hardy winter cover crop mix. (\$17.50 value)

LATE SEASON SEEDS: these will be added to in July and August for Winter harvest. Celeriac, Rutabaga, Purple Turnips, Hakurei Turnips, Parsnips, Watermelon Radish, Daikon Radish, Winter Carrots
