

Access to Static Display and Dingy Beach Areas



For the safety of all Festival participants and spectators, roads leading directly into the Festival site, Porter Street and Cutting Road, will be closed for the Festival.

Boats on trailers for static displays, and cars launching / retrieving boats on the dinghy beach within the Festival site, will be issued an Entry Permit in your Boat Pack to get into the Festival site. The Entry Permit will need to be shown at the entry gate on Cutting Road to gain access into the site, and displayed on the dashboard while the car is within the Festival site.

Due to the Festivals' site safety requirements, entry and exit from the Festival site for boats, trailers and cars will not be available between 9.00am and 5.00pm each day of the Festival.

We are requesting that;

1. Boats on trailers for static displays within the Festival site eg speedboats, dinghies, be in the Festival site and cars out of the site by 9.00 am on both days, and
2. Boats being taken to the Dinghy Beach for launching be in, and cars and trailers out of the site by 9.00am on both days. Should you wish to leave your trailer within the Festival site, a trailer parking only area is available at the northern end of the Festival site under the Hindmarsh Island Bridge.

We also recognise that there may be an instance where getting into and leaving the Festival Site by 9.00am may not be suitable, so we will have an additional entry window at 10.00am and an exit window of 4.00pm. There will be a Marshall at the entrance gate on Cutting Road to let participants in / out at those times.

Like previous Festivals, security will be patrolling the Festival site from 6.00pm Friday until 6.00am Monday. However there is no security fencing for this Festival. You are most welcome to leave your boats & trailers in the Festival site for the duration of the Festival at your own risk.

The speed limit within the Festival Site is walking pace.

For larger boats that require a boat ramp for launching, use the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club boat ramp, or the public boat ramp at the Goolwa Aquatic Club. There is no boat ramp at the Festival site.
