***JULIANA V. UNITED STATES YOUTH PLAINTIFFS
IN DC FOR WEEK OF ACTION***

While the Trump administration works to dismantle climate policy, and delay the *Juliana v. United States* trial, youth plaintiffs aren't holding back: they're taking their message to Washington DC for the ["From Truth to Justice" Week of Action](#).
