Renee Robbins is a Chicago-based visual artist who layers biomorphic forms to create detailed otherworldly environments. The Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum will present a solo exhibition of her work in 2018. She has been awarded public art commissions with Chicago Public Art Group, Wabash Arts Corridor, and the Capital Development Board's Art-In-Architecture program. She has exhibited widely, including exhibitions at Lois Lambert Gallery, Santa Monica, CA; Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory, Batavia, IL; Firecat Projects, Chicago, IL; and the Alden B Dow Museum of Science and Art, Midland, MI. The Chicago Gallery News featured her work as a 'Young Chicago Artist' to watch. The forms in her paintings have been classified by a diatom taxonomist in an artist feature on the US Diatoms database at the University of Colorado. Robbins received her MFA from Michigan State University and a BFA from the University of Kentucky and has been working in Chicago since 2007.
