Year in Review

This past year has been extraordinary for Mission Generation! We realized the long-awaited dream of sustainability in Bolivia as its school program expanded into three more states. The hard work and perseverance of our Bolivian team have helped us to overcome many barriers as they compete against secular textbook providers. At the same time, the chaplain program in Bolivia found phenomenal acceptance as schools welcomed the on-site spiritual counseling and support their students so desperately need.

The school program in Chile moved forward in spite of setbacks caused by devastating earthquakes and flooding in our primary school district locations. Now, we are on track to complete editing and full accreditation of the texts this year.

The program in Paraguay also showed itself resilient despite the unexpected loss of a government contract. We are grateful that the strong foundation laid by the Paraguayan team has enabled direct communication with local schools that want our program.

SCHOOL CHAPLAIN PROGRAM 2015

Early on, Mission Generation recognized that schools are in a strong position to support the well-being, values, and spirituality of young people in a community. Because of our educational curriculum program, students began to ask spiritual questions that teachers were not equipped to answer. Therefore, in 2013, at the request of Bolivian school principals, the School Chaplain Program was initiated to put spiritual counselors on school campuses to reinforce the biblical truths being taught in the classroom, and to essentially, pastor the schools. The School Chaplain

Program transforms a school into an "ecclesia" that can become a church planting opportunity. Chaplain candidates, who are volunteers from local churches, are trained, evaluated, and then matched with schools that have requested them. Chaplains hold school-wide assemblies, host discipleship groups, mentor student chaplains, and build one-on-one relationships with students while on campus. The demand for chaplains is much greater than we could have imagined and we are expanding the School Chaplain Program into more Latin American countries.

CHAPLAIN PROGRAM: TESTIMONY

One recent success helps illustrate how effective a chaplain can be. Sometimes administrators and parents are reluctant to allow chaplains in the schools. To gain trust, the chaplains obtain permission to do a simple presentation and conduct a 26-question survey with the students. These questions identify sin issues that students may be facing. One example would be: "Have you been offered drugs in the last six months?"

The results are often eye-opening for the parents and teachers! In one school, almost 50% of the students answered YES—they had been offered drugs in the last six months. The survey creates an awareness of sin and a hunger in both parents and students to find freedom. Recently, in one of our schools, a chaplain identified a student leader who was doing drugs in a theater class during school hours. With regular visits,

the chaplain developed a relationship with this troubled student and ended up leading him and his whole family to Jesus! The student is now in a rehab program and his family is full of hope. This transformation led to the school requesting a full time chaplain who will disciple students and lead services... inside the school walls!



OUR CURRICULUM

Week by week, year after year, we build a solid foundation of God's way. Some lessons are about relationships, some about financial stewardship, and some about honoring parents, but all come from the Word of God. As we gain favor in the school systems, we teach even more directly about Jesus and God's plan for salvation. For instance, one of our 7th grade lessons is titled "There is a Solution." It starts out by teaching that God created man and woman to steward creation. God told Adam not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil or they would die. Satan seduced them, and Adam and Eve sinned. They died spiritually and were forced to leave the garden. Later in the lesson, the Gospel is clearly communicated. Here's a little bit translated from the Spanish text:

The relationship between God and man needed to be repaired...Man's disobedience had the consequence of death or separation from God. God is very righteous and someone had to be punished for man's disobedience...God loves man so much, He provided a solution: He came to earth Himself as a human being, Jesus Christ, and paid the punishment of separation for all men...God wants us all to choose Him and to respond to His love by believing in Jesus. By trusting in Jesus Christ, our spirit no longer stays dead, but comes to life!

Can you imagine being taught the Gospel by your public school teacher as part of a required school class?

One incredible resource that is "hidden" in the textbooks are QR codes like these. When students scan QR codes with their smartphones, they are taken to an in-depth, interactive Gospel presentation with scripture verses from Romans and a prayer of salvation. So far, these QR codes have escaped the notice of censure and government auditors.




FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

2013 EXPENSES




