

Bellshire Design Center Dress Code Policy

Shirts

- All shirts must have short or long sleeves and must have a collar (polo, dress style, peter pan or turtleneck). The shirts may be any solid color.
- Must be tucked in and remain tucked in at all times.
- Bellshire Design Center school T-shirts are also considered a part of SSA.

Bottoms

- All pants, shorts, skirts, capri style pants, skorts or jumpers must be navy blue, black, or any shade of khaki. Denim Jeans are not permissible. Pants must be worn and fitted at the waistline.
- Skirts, dresses, and shorts must go to the knee and there must be no slits in skirts above the knee.
- Pants with drawstrings are permitted.
- Belts must be worn at all times through the belt loops and buckled.

Coats/Jackets

- Students may wear any color heavy coat to school, but it must be stored in a locker or designated location when the student gets to school. Heavy coats may not be worn in the classroom. Sweaters or pullover windbreakers, without hoods may be worn.
- Large, oversized coats and jackets or trench coats are not permitted within the school building.

Shoes

Appropriate Footwear must be worn at all times. Laces on shoes or sneakers must be tied. Flip-flops and house shoes are not allowed.

Additional Guidelines

- Anything that is distracting or disrupts the instructional day will result in the student being sent home to make the necessary adjustments to their appearance. This includes hairstyles and color.
- All clothing must be the appropriate size. Tight, baggy or sagging shirts or pants are not allowed.
- Clothing must not have drug, alcohol, gang related, gambling, or other such messages or pictures.
- Clothing must be free of holes, rips, or tears. See-through clothing is prohibited.
- Spiked accessories, oversized jewelry or belt buckles and inappropriate head coverings such as bandanas or do-rags cannot be worn during school time.
