

Glendale Spanish Immersion Dress Code Policy

We try to keep our Dress Code very simple. Pants, shorts, Capri pants, skirts, skorts or jumpers may be worn in black, navy blue, or khaki. Kindergarten and first grade boys do not have to wear belts. All other grade levels wear belts if there are loops on the pants.

All shirts must be tucked in. We adhere to the Metro policy 1737 concerning pockets. Only side pockets are allowed. NO pockets on pants on upper or lower leg.

Shirts must be button down, turtleneck, mock, polo, any color and plain. The PTO will have Spirit wear, hoodies, and shirts with the logo on it for sale during the school year.

Hoodies may be worn to school, but must be kept in lockers. On cold days, you may want to send plain sweaters for your students. All Glendale Spirit wear may be worn on Fridays, so students can enjoy these types of clothing. During the year we will have Free Dress Days so students may wear whatever they wish. You will receive phone notification of these days.

We ask for all children to wear play shoes, no flip flops, or sandals without straps. All children go outside on pretty days, and play shoes are most appropriate to prevent accidents.

Please make sure students are clean and neat. During winter months, girls may wear tights of any type.

If students come to school out of dress code, we will call parents and ask them to bring appropriate clothing for the day. Sometimes students have accidents and Glendale has a small supply of extra clothing to help out in these situations. Our families enjoy the simplicity of this code and we hope you find it easy to understand.
