

Dan Mills Elementary School DRESS CODE POLICY

Shirts with short or long sleeves and a collar (polo, dress-style with buttons, or turtleneck) are acceptable. The shirts can be ANY SOLID color. All shirts should be properly buttoned and must be the correct size for the child. Shirts hanging to the knees will not be allowed. If the shirt is too long, it must be tucked into the bottoms. Polo style dresses are allowed in any solid color.

Pants, shorts, capri pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers are to be khaki, navy blue, or black. Also, your child will be allowed to wear blue jeans. Jeans, as well as, all other bottoms are to be plain—no sequins, no colorful designs down the front or sides, and no holes. Jeans, just as other clothing, must be the correct size. Shorts, jumpers, dresses, skirts or skorts must extend below the fingertips.

Appropriate sizes are defined as no more than one size smaller or one size larger than the student's actual clothing size. Pants, shorts, capri pants, skorts, and skirts must fit at the waist and must not sag. Belts and tucking in of shirts are not required unless the shirt is too long.

Sweaters, light-weight jackets and hoodies (without the hood on the head) in any solid color can be worn and must be the correct size.

Footwear must be worn at all times. Laces on shoes or sneakers must be tied. The shoes that your child wears should be safe for your child while he/she is in PE or at recess. No house shoes are allowed.

Head coverings such as bandanas, scarves, sweatbands, caps, do-rags or hairnets are not to be worn or seen during school hours.

Students' dress and grooming must be clean and neat. Clothes and appearance must be safe and not disruptive to the educational process.

Consequences for violation of dress code: Note will be sent home and/or parent will be called.
