In the Hallway

Rules	Student Behavior
Safety First	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Zone zero whether alone or in a line.-Stay in number order.-<u>Walk</u> two tiles from the wall.-Save all questions & comments until we return to the classroom.
On task	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Listen and follow all directions given to you by the teacher or substitute in order to get quickly and quietly to the desired destination.-Raise your hand if you need anything.
Always Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Keep hands feet and objects to yourself.-Don't disturb other classes in any way.
Ready to learn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Have what you need to take to the desired location.

In the Restroom

Rules	Student Behavior
Safety First	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Zone zero whether alone or with the class.-Wait patiently in line.
On Task	Listen and follow all directions given to you by the teacher or substitute so that you can use the restroom quickly and quietly.
Always Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Keep hands feet and objects to yourself.-Place trash in the trashcan.-Wash your hands.
Ready to Learn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Use the restroom with the class. (You go when we go or you don't go at all)

In the Cafeteria

Rules	Student Behavior
Safety First	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Zone zero when <u>walking</u> to and from lunch.-Sit in assigned seat.-Zone 2 to talk to neighbor.
On Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Listen and follow all directions given to you by the lunch ladies and teachers so that you can eat your lunch and that others can eat their lunch too.-Raise your hand if you need anything.
Always Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Use kind words.-Say “please” & “thank you”.-Eat your own food.-Keep hands feet and objects to yourself.-Clean up after yourself.
Ready to Eat	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Bring food from home with you to lunch.-Bring money for snacks with you to lunch.-Use the restroom & wash hands before lunch. <p>(no leaving the lunchroom during lunch time)</p>

During Specials

Rules	Student Behavior
Safety First	-Zone zero when <u>walking</u> to and from specials.
On Task	Listen and follow all directions given to you by the teacher or substitute so that you can learn and that others can learn too.
Always Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Use kind words.-Do your best to learn.-Do your best to help others learn.-Say “please” & “thank you”.-Keep hands feet and objects to yourself.-Clean up after yourself.
Ready to Learn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Take care of your things.-Bring any required items to class.

On the Bus

Rules	Student Behavior
Safety First	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Zone zero when <u>walking</u> to and from the bus.-Stay with your dismissal group afterschool.-Zone 1 (whisper) during the ride so the driver can focus on the road.-Stay in your seat.
On Task	<p>Listen and follow all directions given to you by the bus driver so that you can get to and from school safely.</p>
Always Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Use kind words.-Do your best to help younger students.-Say “please” & “thank you”.-Keep hands feet and objects to yourself.-Clean up after yourself.
Ready to Learn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Listen for your bus to be called.-Have all of your belongings with you and packed in your backpack.

In the Classroom

Rules	Student Behavior
Safety First	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Zone tones listed on the board for different activities.-Line up in number order.-Stay in assigned area.
On Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Listen and follow all directions given to you by the teacher or substitute so that you can learn and that others can learn too.-Raise your hand if you need assistance.
Always Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Use kind words.-Do your best to learn.-Do your best to help others learn.-Say “please” & “thank you”.-Keep hands feet and objects to yourself.-Clean up after yourself.
Ready to Learn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Take care of your things.-Bring your backpack, binder, and completed assignments each day.-Have necessary school supplies.
