## Bellevue Middle School Prep 2015-2016 Standard School Attire Policy

The following guidelines will be effective for the 2015-2016 school year as it relates to dress code at Bellevue Middle School Prep. All students and parents are asked to adhere to these policies as stated.

### ***Miscellaneous Items (NOT PERMITTED)***

- Hair scarves, hair bonnets, hats/head coverings (permission granted with official religious exception)
- Bandanas, gloves, sunglasses
- Athletic sandals, sandals **without** sling-backs, house shoes/slippers
- Tight-fitting or revealing clothing

**Each morning teachers will conduct a dress code check in first period.** If a child is out of SSA, he/she will be immediately sent to the office and our campus support personnel will call a parent. If the parent can bring proper clothes, the child will wait until appropriate clothing arrives, change, and return to class. If appropriate clothing is unavailable, the child will not be able to return to class and will have to complete their class work in ISS. Each time this occurs, it will be documented on the student behavior log. Repeated SSA violations will lead to consequences such as ISS, OSS, and other disciplinary action.
