

**DuPont Hadley Middle School
Standard School Attire
2016-2017**

Students are expected to comply with standard school attire

- Shirts – Collared shirts of any **solid** color. Must be the top shirt unless worn with a sweater, vest, or blazer. Shirts may have the top two buttons unbuttoned, unless it is deemed inappropriate by school personnel.
- Pants – Any solid color except shades of white–**Dress Casual**–No jeans, no cutoffs, no athletic (yoga, spandex, mesh) pants. Pants may have cargo pockets.
- Skirts/Shorts–Any solid color except shades of white–**Dress Casual**–No jeans, no cutoffs, no athletic (yoga, spandex, mesh) shorts. Length must be below student’s fingertips all the way around. Shorts may have cargo pockets.
- Dresses– Any solid color with sleeves. Length must be below student’s fingertips all the way around.
- Leggings –must be worn under skirt, dress or shorts that meet finger tip length
- DuPont Hadley shirts, sweatshirts and hoodies (unmodified) that have been purchased from the school/PTO or part of a school program (GREAT, Field Day, etc) will also be allowed each day. Shirts will be tucked.
- Sagging or semi-sagging–No Sagging–(when sitting a student should not be sitting on the belt or waistline).
- Outerwear – Coats cannot be worn in the building or during the school day. Light jackets, DuPont Hadley sweatshirts and hoodies, and sweatshirts (of a solid color) may be worn. SSA approved shirts (solid color collared or DHMP) must be worn under light jackets and solid color sweatshirts.
- Undershirts – worn under the collared shirt –must not have writing visible under or through the collared shirt.
- Tucked – All shirts are to be tucked into the pants, skirts, shorts.
- Torn Clothing–Students clothing is to be free from rips and tears.
- Appropriate Footwear – No Flip-Flops or slides – DuPont Hadley considers any shoe that has an open heel a flip-flop and therefore is not allowed. Shoes must have a closed or strapped heel. Students are not allowed to wear house shoes of any type to school as their footwear.
- Tattoos–Tattoos that display illegal or inappropriate words or images are prohibited.
- Spray Items–Students are not to bring spray deodorants, perfumes, colognes, or hairsprays to school due to safety concerns.
- Accessories–Chains, spiked accessories, oversized jewelry, oversized belt buckles, belt buckles with concealed weapons, or any type of drug paraphernalia are prohibited from school.
- Head Coverings–Bandanas, hairnets, scarves, sweatbands, caps, and hoods are all prohibited (except for religious reasons).
- Writing on Skin–Writings on arms, legs, hands, face, etc... with markers, pens, or pencils are prohibited.

Any outfit that proves to be a distraction to the learning environment is prohibited.
